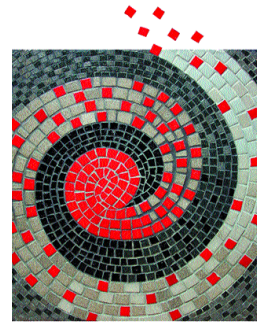


# *Acknowledgements*
